New Worship Series January-February 2022

Starting January 9, the next eight Worship Services will focus on developing and maintaining healthy relationships with God and one another. What do healthy relationships look like? How can we tell if there's room for improvement? How can we make any improvements we identify? Our pastors, KyongJung and Ken, will alternate bringing the sermon each week. After worship, they will continue the topic of the day in a more informal discussion hour. Everyone is encouraged to participate in both hours. Along the way, especially as things happen in our lives and in the world, questions may arise for us along these lines, and if one of us is wondering about something, others likely are as well. And these themes are flexible. So please feel free to ask KyongJung and/or Ken to address your questions in upcoming sermons as well as in the discussion hour.

1. Jan. 9. *Identity and relationship with God: the foundation of healthy relationships with others*. KyongJung preaching.
2. Jan. 16. *What Is Love? Grace & Truth*. Rom 5.8; Jn 1.1-14, Ken preaching.
3. Jan. 23. *Relationships in the church: what we hope, what we fear, what we get, and why*. KyongJung preaching.
4. Jan. 30. *Forgiveness, part 1: what we need when relationships go south*. What is forgiveness? Ken preaching.

5. Feb. 6. *Forgiveness, part 2: how to achieve forgiveness.* (Both for ourselves and how to help others with it). KyongJung preaching.
6. Feb. 13. *Boundaries, part 1: discerning and protecting our own boundaries.* Ken preaching.
7. Feb. 20. *Boundaries, part 2: discerning and respecting the boundaries of God and others.* KyongJung preaching.
8. Feb. 27. *Overcoming relationship traps: pride, fear, sadness, anger, stress, shame, etc.* Ken preaching.
